STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the rights to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later, but not including the registration fee, book fee and uniform fee. A student may not cancel by telephoning the school or not attending the class.
